**INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON OIL POLLUTION PREPAREDNESS,  
RESPONSE AND CO-OPERATION, 1990**

**Accession by Algeria, Lebanon and Gabon**

The Secretary-General of the International Maritime Organization has the honour to refer to the International Convention on Oil Pollution Preparedness, Response and Co-operation, 1990, and to state that, in accordance with article 15, accession by the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria, the Lebanese Republic and the Gabonese Republic was effected by the deposit of instruments on the dates indicated:

	<b>Date of deposit of instrument</b>	<b>Date of entry into force</b>
People's Democratic Republic of Algeria	8 March 2005	8 June 2005
Lebanese Republic	30 March 2005	30 June 2005
Gabonese Republic	12 April 2005	12 July 2005

The Convention will enter into force for these States on the dates indicated, in accordance with the provisions of article 16.

There are, at present, eighty-five Contracting States to the Convention.
